









































Instructions for Chapters of Acts Booklets.

Print all 3 pages on regular copy paper. Make one copy of cover page (1st page) for every 2 children. Make 7 copies of booklet page (2nd page) for each child. Make 1 copy of picture page for each child. To make booklets, fold the 2nd page in half horizontally. Then fold in half vertically. Cut top half down the middle to the fold. This creates a small booklet with 2 flaps. Glue the back of one of these pages to the front of another. Continue doing this with four booklets. You should now have a book with 8 flaps. Glue the cover for chapters 1-8 on the front of this booklet. Go through this process again with the last 3 booklets creating another booklet with 6 flaps. Glue the cover for chapters 9-14 on the front of this booklet. I have found that these thicker booklets need to be trimmed slightly before placing in the project folder. Trim off a little less than 1/4" from right side and bottom with paper cutter. Cut apart the 14 pictures and place in a small baggie or envelope. The student will glue the picture for chapter one on the front of the first flap, lift the flap and write what happened in that chapter then draw a picture of the event or events in the frame below.
