45 Goliath/sword

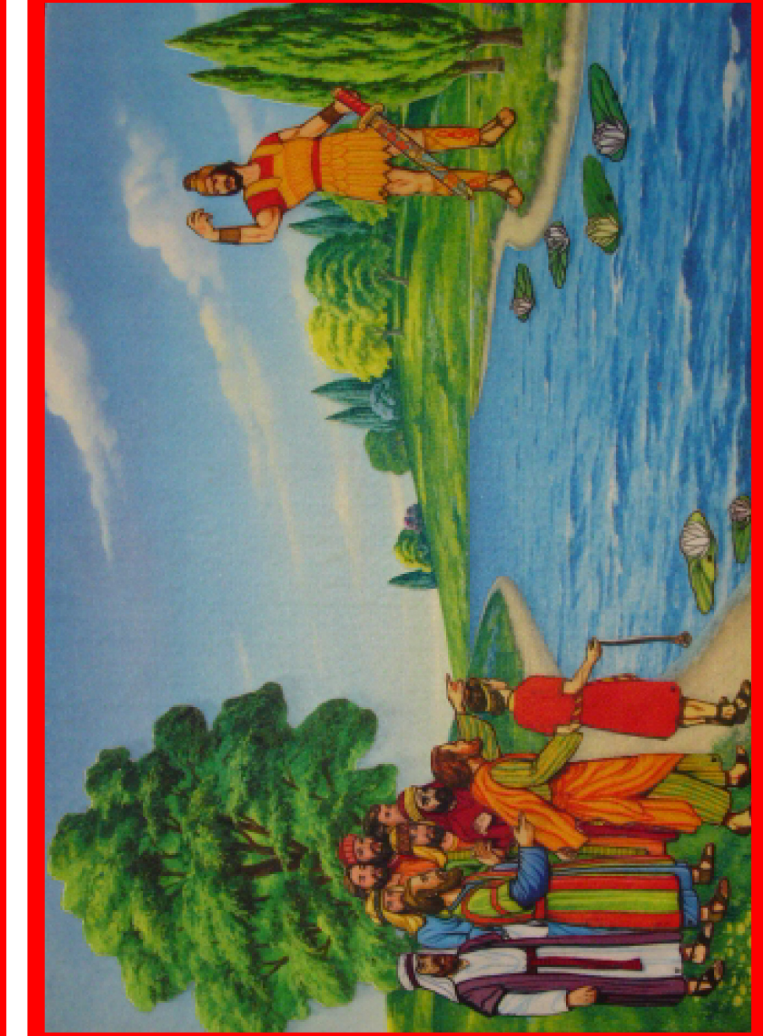

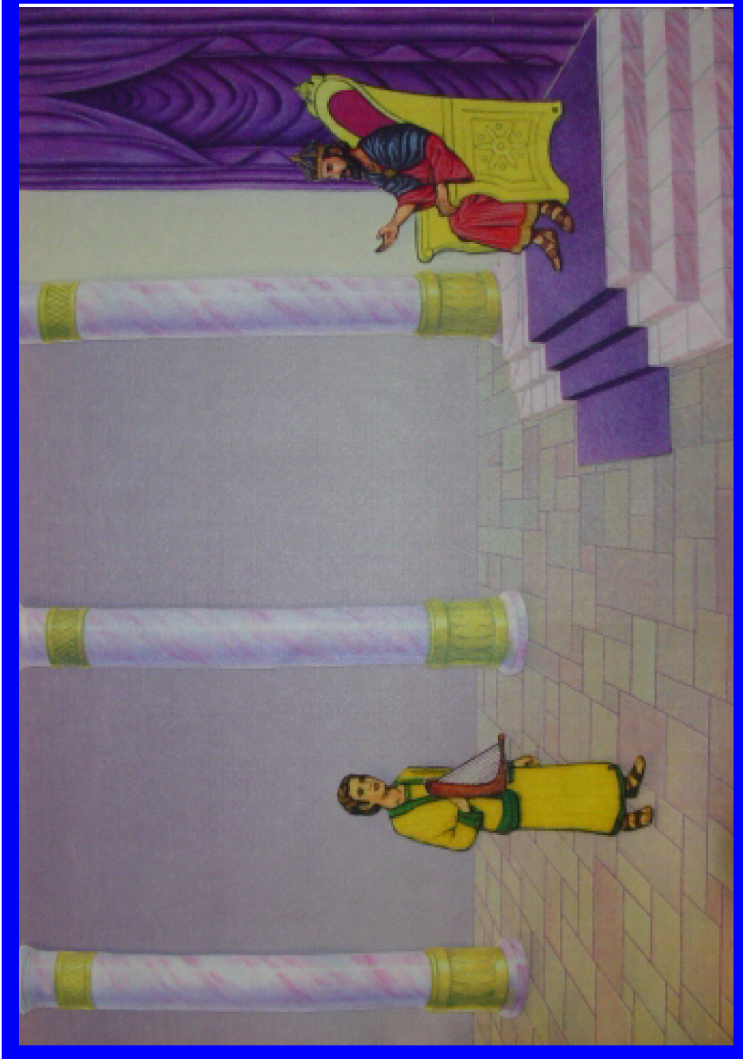
