Print on card stock. Cut on dotted lines. Fold on solid lines. You will have 2 booklets.

To make the scroll, cut a strip of white paper about $8.5^{\prime\prime}$ x 2". Glue the very center of a length of ribbon to the left of the inside of the booklet. During class, the student can write a passage from the Old Testament or a few of the facts listed below. Roll the scroll up and tie it in place with the ribbon.

To make the Bible, cut a piece of black or brown construction paper and two pieces of white copy paper $8.5^{\circ} \times 2.75^{\circ}$. Stack them, then fold them in half. Staple to form a Small book. During class, the student can write a passage from the New Testament or a few of the facts listed below. Glue the book on the right side inside the larger booklet.

Write on Scroll:

For Jews only Jesus lived during this law. Animal sacrifices offered daily. Given to Moses on Mt Sinai. Found in Old Testament

Write on pages of Bible:

For everyone
Began after Jesus died.
Jesus sacrificed once for our sins.
Given to Apostles by Holy Spirit.
Found in New Testament.

Send home with student of glue in project folder.
