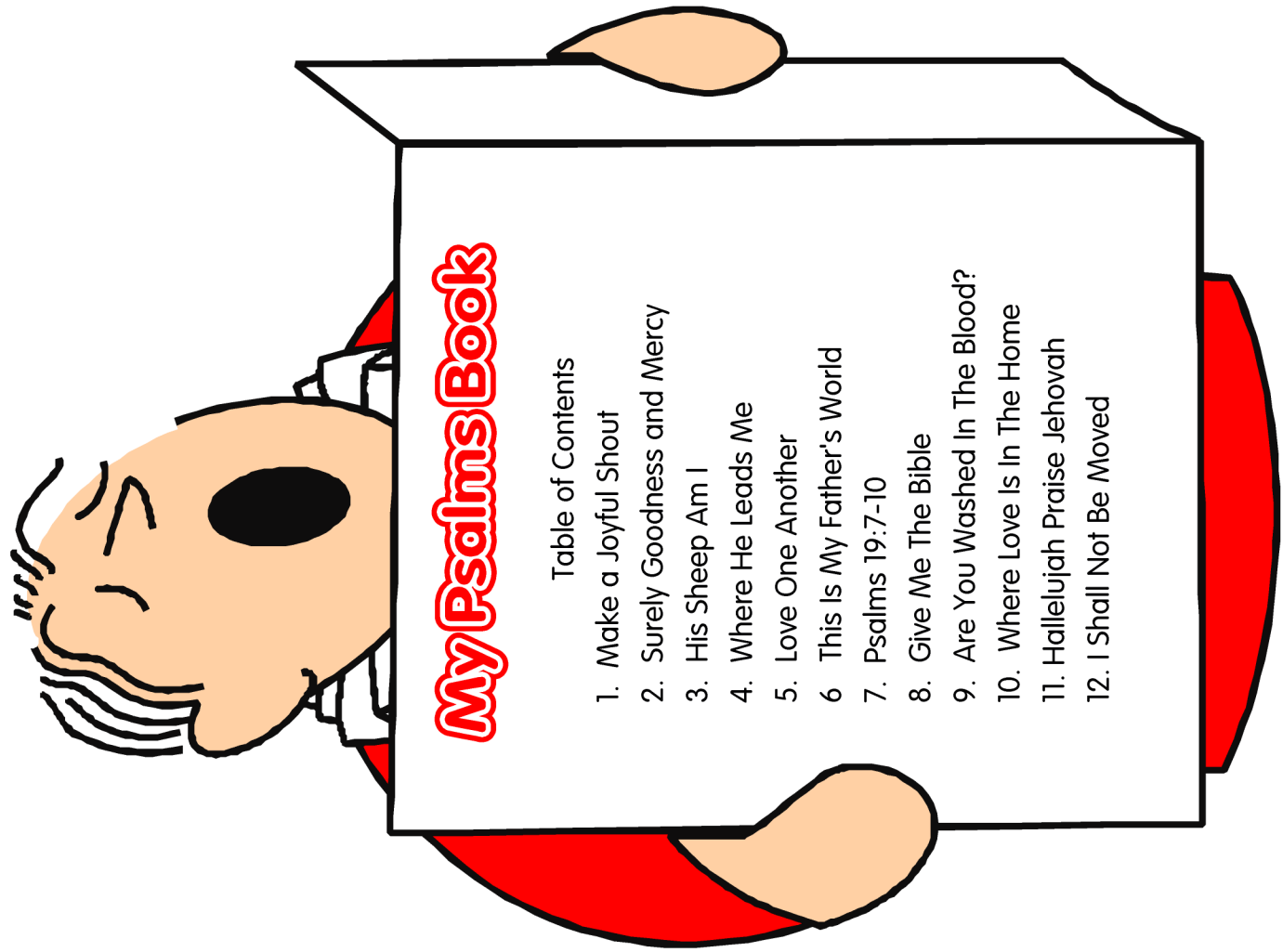

And His truth endures to all generations.



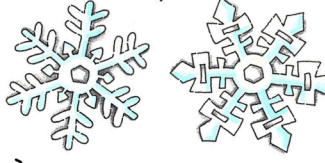

In whose eyes a vile person is despised,

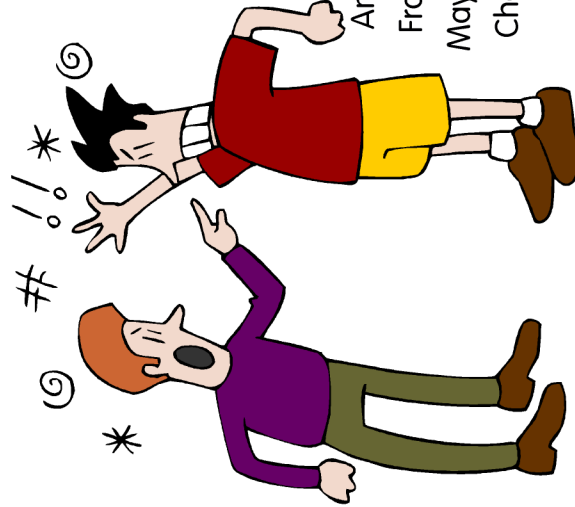

Do you rest each moment in the Crucified?

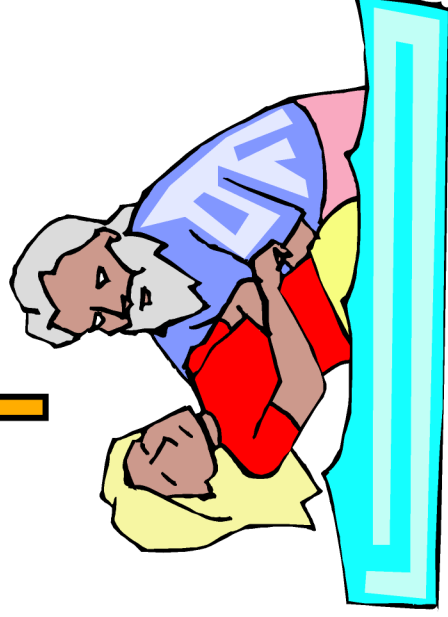

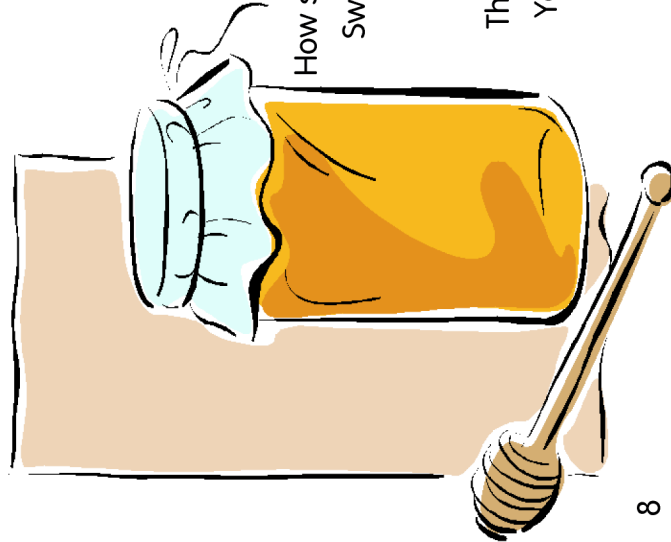

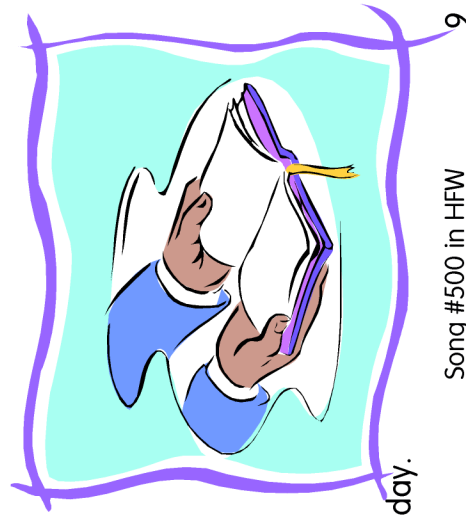
Give me the Bible, star of gladness gleaming,

I rest me in the thought of rocks and trees of skies and seas.

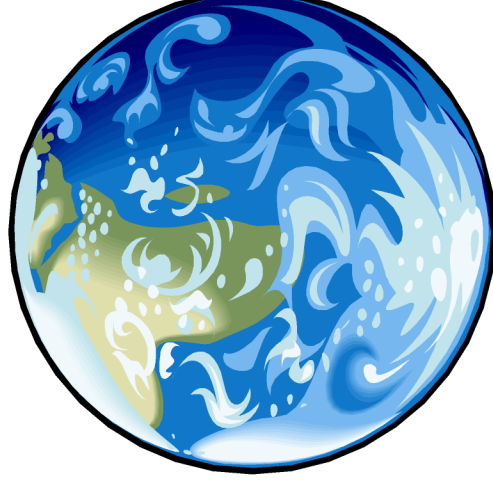

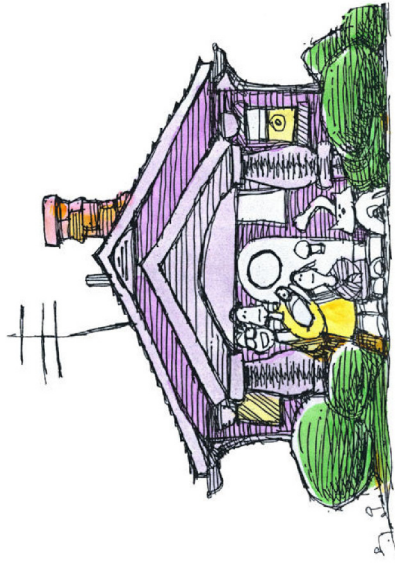

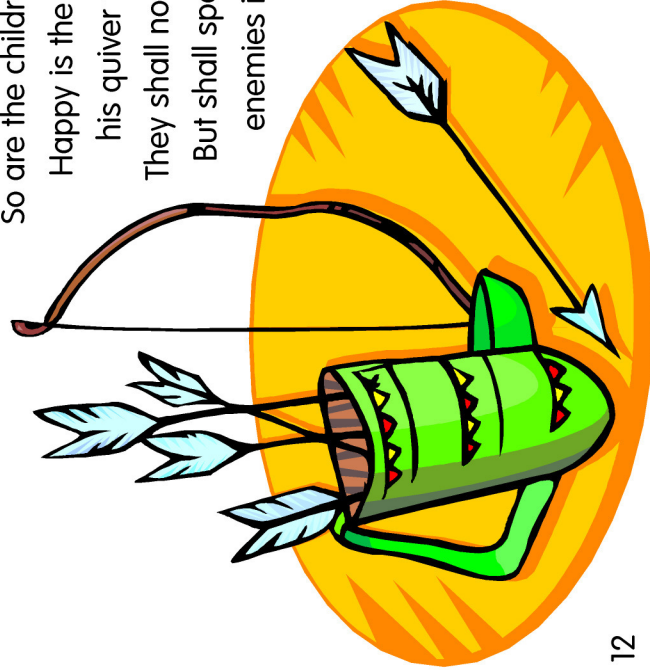
Psalm 127

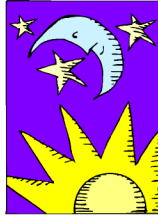

Praise the Lord!

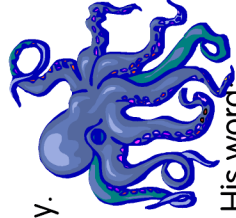
Praise the Lord from the heavens; Praise Him in the heights!
