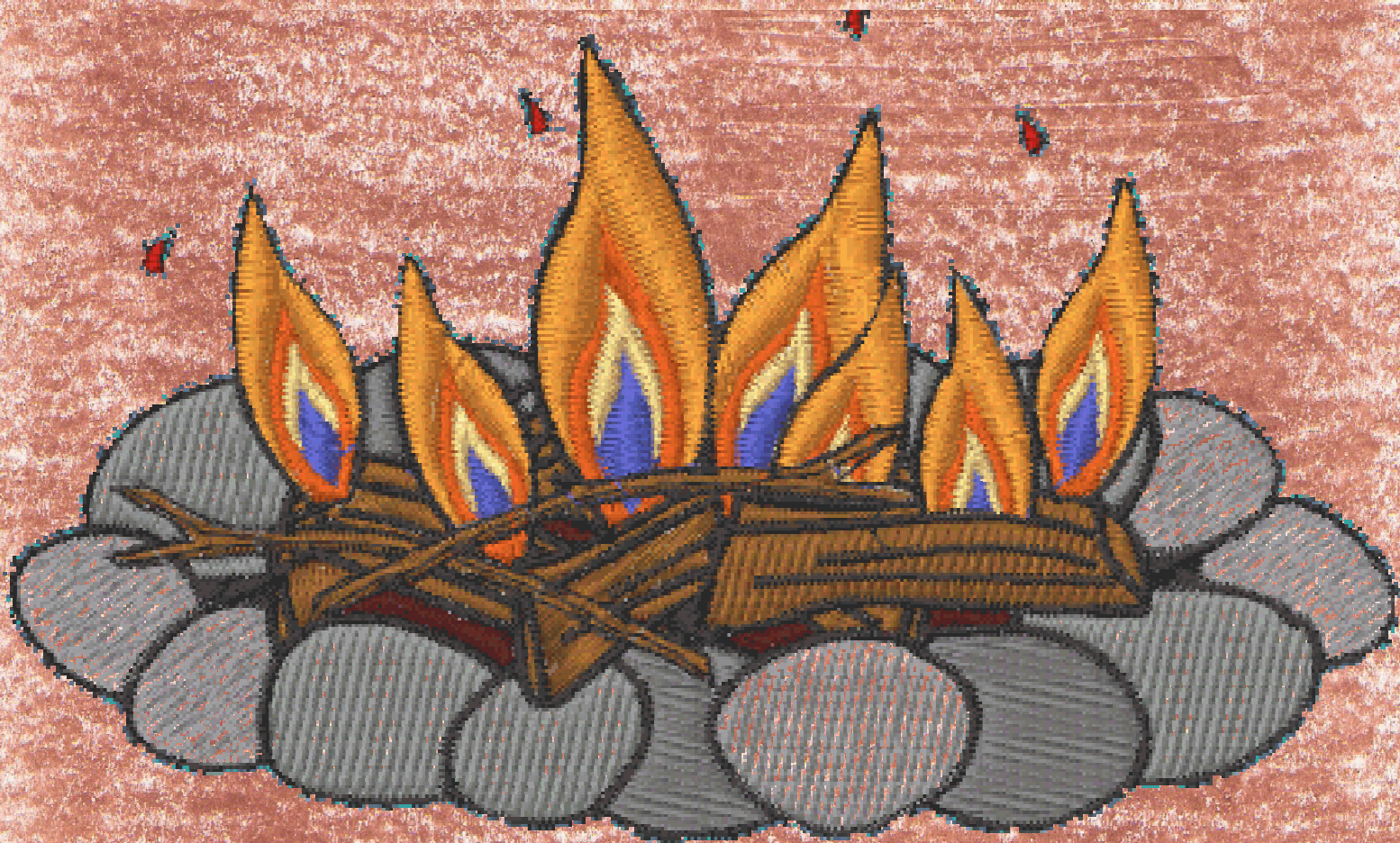
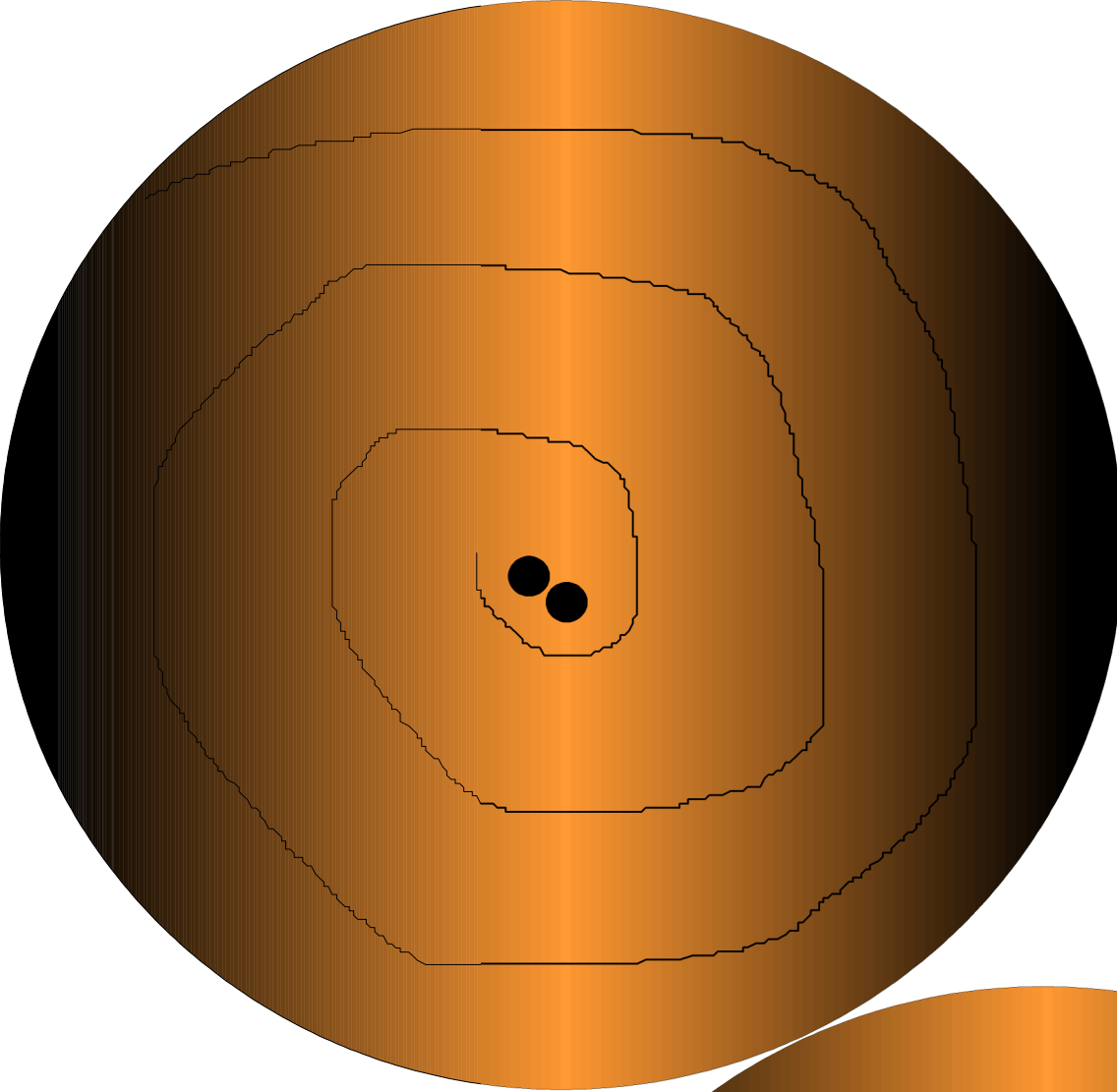


Paul is Bit by a Snake

Print first 2 pages on cardstock. Print this page on regular paper. Fold first 2 pages in half. Glue side-by-side so the hand on page with story is on top of hand on full color page. Glue one circle on top of the other so both sides are colored. Cut circle on spiraled line. This is your snake.

I trimmed the snake's tail about 2 inches. It just seemed to be too big.

Before class, lay the snake face down on top of the campfire. Glue just the tip of the table to the campfire. During class, put a dot of glue on the head of the snake. Close the page and let it set for a minute. When you open the page, the snake will be biting Paul's hand.
