

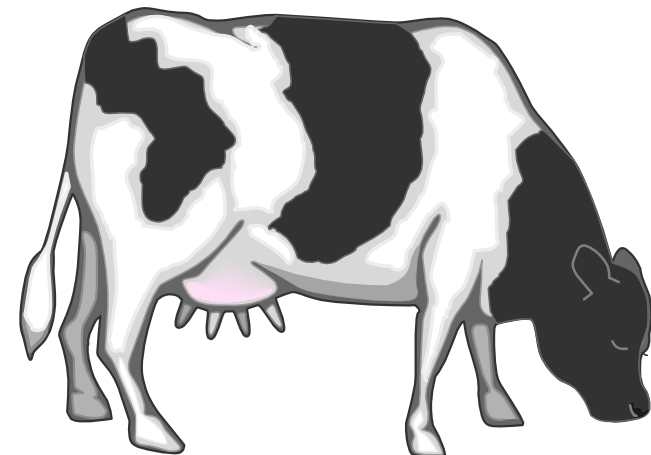
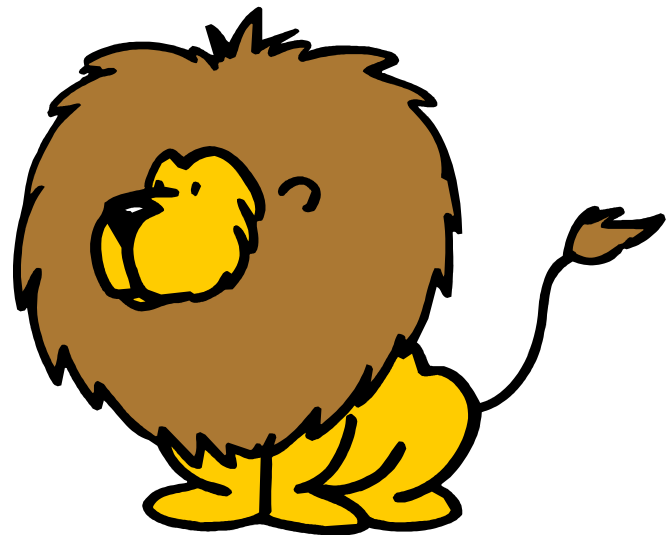
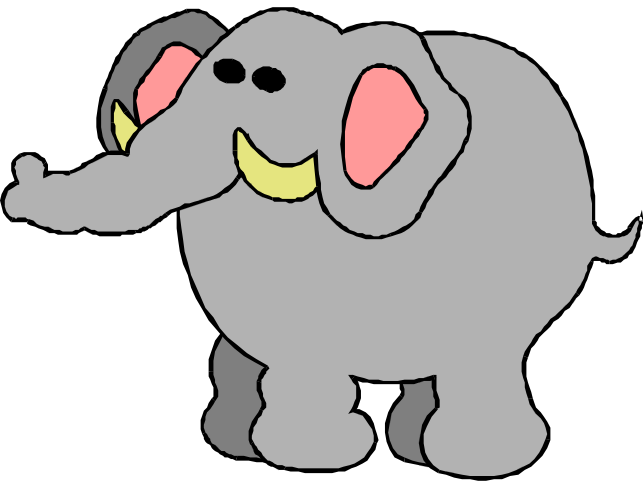
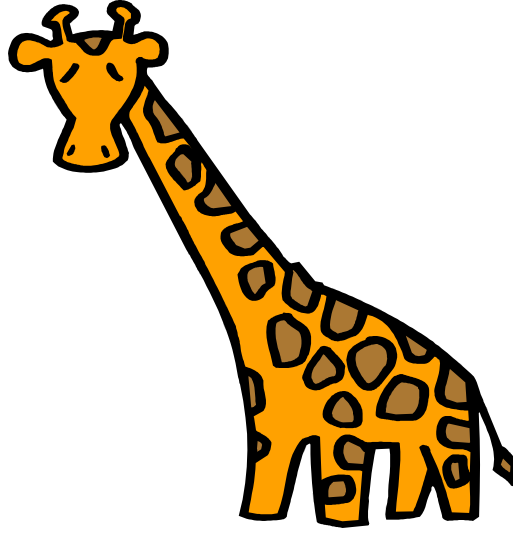
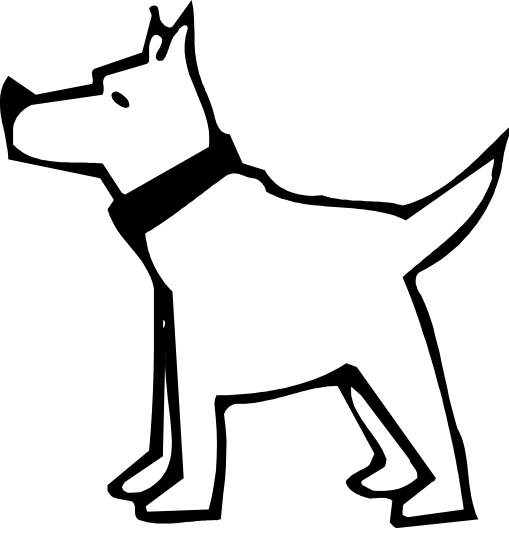
Peter Sees a Vision

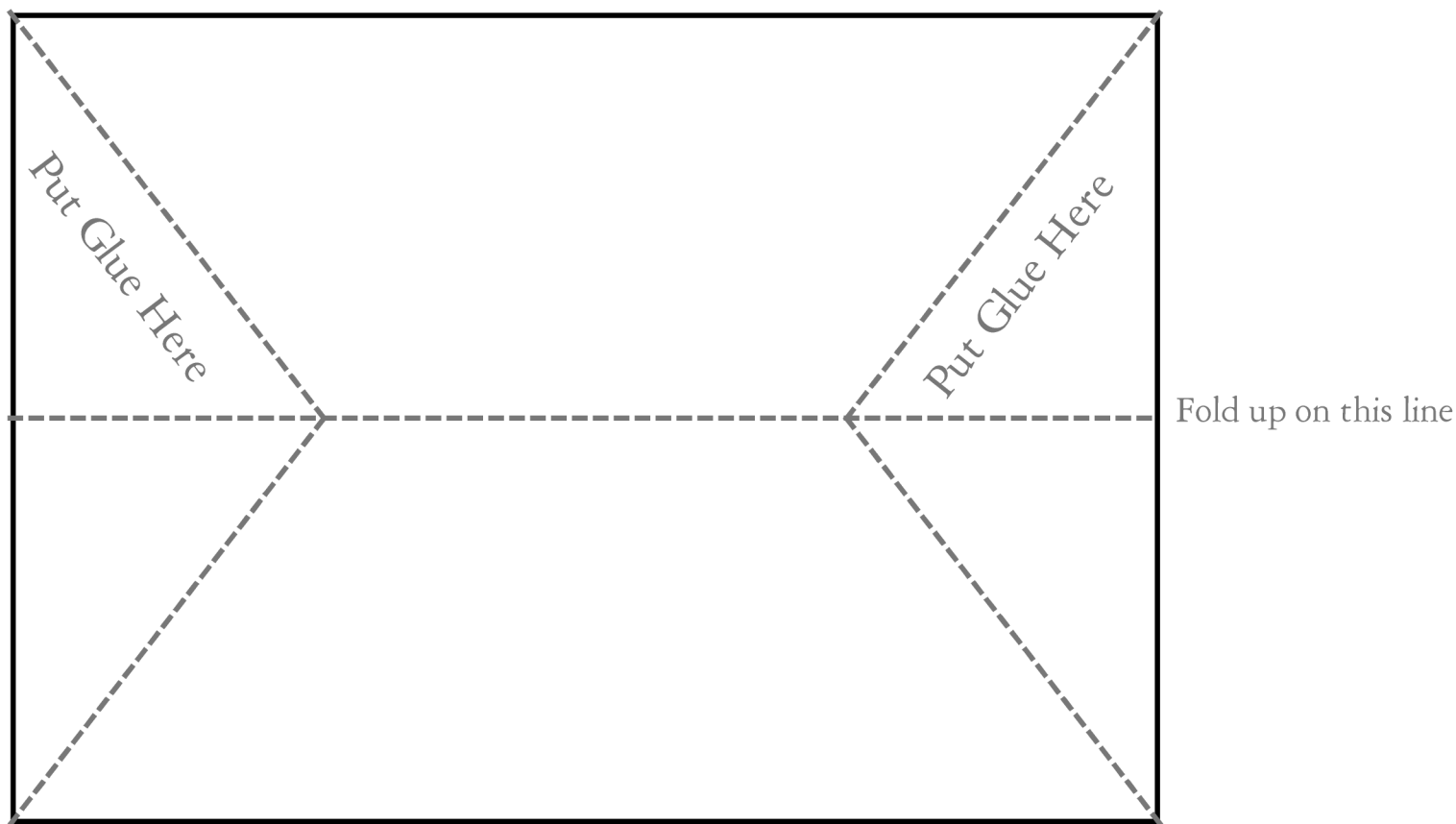

Copy 1 page for each child on cardstock and cutout. Cut around loosely so pieces are not so hard to cut out and take care of. Let each child put their animals in the "sheet" for Peter's vision.



Print background from cardstock. Copy this page from cardstock (or trace image above and cut out).

Fold bottom to top on horizontal line. Fold on diagonal lines to form triangles on ends. Open up rectangle. Push triangles to the inside. You'll now have a trapezoid (bet you never thought you'd use that word after you got out of school).

Glue side of triangle that says: put glue here. Close trapezoid again. This will make a pocket for the animals. Glue the pocket to the background page of Peter Sees a Vision. Place assorted animals inside.
