Print all 3 pages on regular copy paper. A different color on the inside would be nice but not required. Cut out title and tab label to glue on cover.

Inside sheets: Insert brads after each question and before each answer. Glue to inside of file folder. The activity will be sturdier if it is glued down entirely, not just around the edges. Laminate (I used clear contact paper). Carefully, with an X-acto blade, cut an x on top of each brad. Lift the little flaps and tuck them underneath the brad. Tie a string securely around the brads that are next to the question. Instruct students to just wrap string around once when answering questions. It can be difficult to unwrap the string if it has been wrapped many times. If you would like to make it more challenging, cover up the verses listed with the question before copying.
