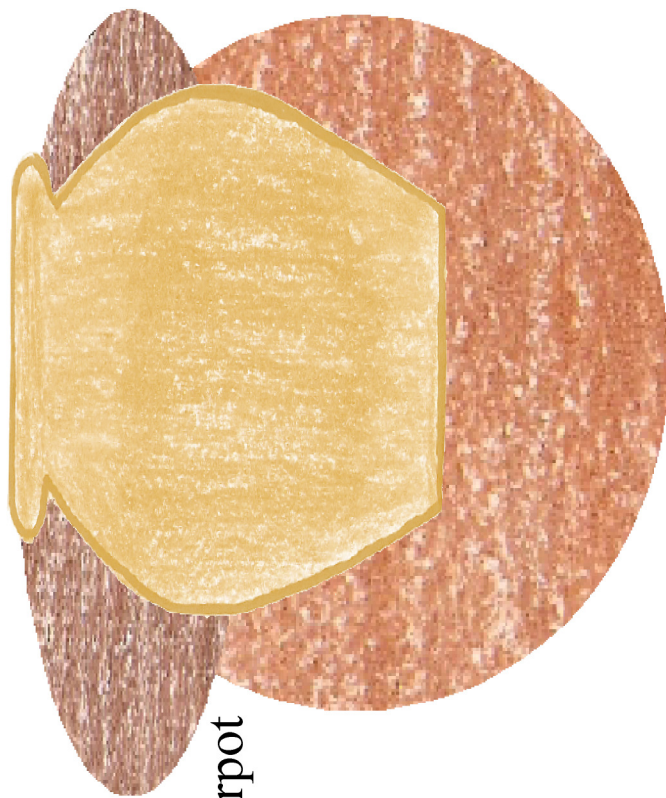


Jesus Turns The Water Into Wine

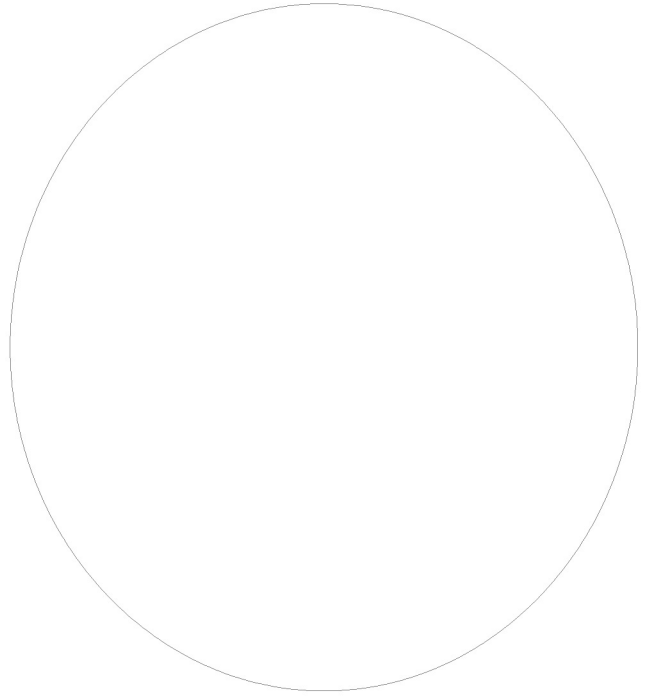

Print both pages on cardstock. Cut out white circle and waterpot (with background). Put brad in center of white circle (you may need to play around with the placement of the brad) and glue the water pot on top of the white circle (brad is hidden inside). After it dries push brad into position on background picture. The waterpot should be positioned so that when it is upright, water is being poured in, when it is tilted to the left, wine pours out.. You might want to outline the waterpot with a sharpie to give it more definition. You may also trim the circle/background of the waterpot piece so it doesn't cover up too much of the servants' legs. This is a tricky one to explain how to do but once you figure it out, it's really cute and the kids love it.
