
Using regular copy paper, print front to back as follows:

Instructions, Title, 14 and 3 to pages 2, 15, 4 and 13

Pages 12, 5, 10 and 7 to pages 6, 11, 8 and 9

Cut pages on horizontal dashed line. There are 2 blank pages at the end -- pages 14 and 15. You can just leave them blank, have the students draw more pictures of God's creation or glue them together to shut them.

You can have each child illustrate their own book or do as I did and make it a group effort. Assign a picture. Let them decorate using colored pencils. You will then outline the pictures with a thin Sharpie to highlight the details. Scan the pictures into your computer, reduce/crop/adjust as necessary to fit a quarter page. Either paste them onto the correct page using a software program or do it manually.
